This course is the benchmark in approved basic and advanced first aid courses. The 2-day basic course covers a range of topics including the responsibilities of the first responder, traumatic and medical emergencies, resuscitation and AED. The 5-day intermediate course includes all the basic modules, and in addition teaches more advanced techniques such as medical oxygen, airways and use of resuscitators. Also, the use of immobilisation aids is also taught.
