This course is for small marine craft operating up to 60nm offshore. The course is designed to provide students with the skills to save a life at sea, call for assistance as well as assist in the evacuation of an ill person off a ship by helicopter.

- Calling for assistance & Helicopter evacuation
- First aid kits & drug administration
