

Oropharyngeal Airways



An oropharyngeal airway is used to assist in maintaining an open airway in an unconscious patient who either is or is not breathing. This course teaches students when to use an airway, correct sizing, insertion and removal of an oropharyngeal (guedel) airway. This course (due to its short nature) can only be combined with another Revive course, but is ideal for inclusion on CPR, AED or general first aid courses.
